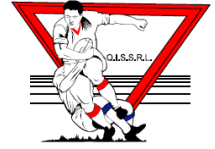

Playing Fields

All games will be played at St Laurence's playing fields, corner of Beenleigh and Nathan roads, Runcorn. Parking for team buses will be on site within the St Laurence's complex and marshalls will be on-site to assist with parking directions each morning. Spectator car parking will be on the surrounding roads of the playing fields.

Canteen and barbecue facilities will be in operation throughout the duration of the carnival, selling a variety of hot and cold healthy food options mixed in with traditional footy day food.

Opening Ceremony

This person needs only to be reliable (could be a student) and does not need to be qualified, as the referees will give them some coaching before and during the carnival.
