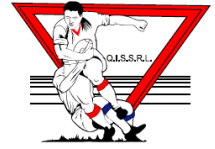

Hello All

Planning is well underway for this years' carnival. We have included a number of reminder items from the last newsletter as well as a number of additional items for your information.

#### **Playing Fields**

As a reminder, all games will be played at St Laurence's playing fields, corner of Beenleigh and Nathan roads, Runcorn. Parking for team buses will be on site within the St Laurence's complex and marshals will be on-site to assist with parking directions each morning. Spectator car parking will be on the surrounding roads of the playing fields.

Canteen and barbecue facilities will be in operation throughout the duration of the carnival, selling a variety of hot and cold healthy food options mixed in with traditional footy day food. In the next newsletter, a full menu will be provided so that you can discuss with your teams the food options available and prices for items.

#### **Opening Ceremony**

**Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June @ 5:00 pm – Queensland Sport and Athletics Centre, Kessels Road, Nathan**

The Opening Ceremony is a joint event with QISSN and is an important event as it reinforces the spirit of the Confraternity and QISSN Carnivals and reminds us all of our responsibilities to our teams, the opposition and each other.

It is requested that teams be seated in their allocated places by 4:45pm to ensure a prompt start. Parking at the QSAC will be via the Kessels road entrance. Parking marshals will help direct you on your arrival.

### **Carnival Dinner**

**Tuesday Night 29<sup>th</sup> June - 7pm for 7:30pm Wynnum Leagues Club, Wondall Road, Wynnum West.**

The Carnival Dinner on Tuesday is our opportunity to publicly thank those people and organisations without whose generosity, the carnival would not exist. We have been ably assisted by the Men of League Foundation in sourcing guest speakers and appearances by NRL players throughout the carnival. The Men of League Foundation have also donated a number of memorabilia items for auction on the night of the dinner. Guest speakers and auction items will be announced at a later date.

Each team is allocated three tickets for the dinner. The cost of these will be deducted from your nomination fee. Extra team personnel and other supporters will have to purchase a ticket at \$60 each. Numbers will be limited so if you have additional people wanting to attend, could you please return **FORM B** with numbers listed by **1st June**. Payment for all additional tickets will be required at the coaches and managers meeting on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June.

There will **not** be any official activity planned for the players during this function.

### **AGM**

**Wednesday Afternoon commencing at 3:30pm – St Laurence's playing fields clubroom**

Each school needs to provide at least an official to attend this important event. Attendance at the AGM on Wednesday afternoon is vital as often details come to light which all member schools should have the opportunity to debate, before decisions are made for the Confraternity. If any voting is required during the meeting, each school has 2 votes. During this meeting, referees and selectors give a report and as a result, some changes to the carnival regulations could be made.

Nibbles and drinks (beer and soft drink only) will be supplied.

### **Program**

It is required that each school/college supply their team spiel, a team jersey photo and College crest in a jpeg file (This information is required by email using **FORM C** due **4<sup>th</sup> May**). We will also need the names of the team players, coach, manager, trainer and Principal (**FORM D** due **10<sup>th</sup> May**).

### **Touch Judges**

As with previous years, because there are so many games, it will be imperative for each team (to endeavour) to bring a touch judge with them. This person needs only to be reliable (could be a student) and does not need to be qualified, as the referees will give them some coaching before and during the carnival. It was decided previously that they could be used for their own school game. Thanking you in advance.
